



LEGACY



1993 - A few people met in a basement here in Sylvan Lake to start the Alliance Community Church. Jesus was their foundation and their focus. The church grew and began to meet in the Community Centre.

1996 - Purchased the BHL Lumber Yard on our current property. They renovated the existing building to make a 150-seat room as well as a small foyer and nursery. The church continued to grow.

2002 - Church needed to expand. Because of their sacrifice, vision, and commitment, we are here today in this facility. The church continues to grow.

2021 - April of 2021, we began a capital campaign to raise \$1.5 million to purchase land (as well as some extra for development costs, loan fees, and consultant costs).
